ONE CHURCH

- Can not be divided, just as Christ can not be divided
- Established by God, Known by God, Predestined by God, Called by God, Regenerated/Redeemed by God, Justified by God, Sanctified by God, Preserved by God, Glorified by God
- One Body of Christ, past, present and future

HOLY CHURCH

- Other – set apart/not common
- Moral purity
- The Church is holy by virtue of God uniting her to/in Christ

CATHOLIC CHURCH

- Fullness/perfection/completeness/wholeness/nothing lacking
- Christ makes Her Catholic
 - Universal
 - Invisible
 - Trans-historical
 - Trans-geographical
 - Encompasses all the cosmos in the sense of:
 - Jew and Gentile
 - Male and Female
 - Rich and Poor
 - Well and Sick
 - White/Black/Red/Yellow/Brown
 - Young and Old
 - Free and Slave
 - Etc

APOSTOLIC CHURCH

- Embraces the teaching of the Prophets and the Apostles
- As Christ was sent by the Father and the Holy Spirit was sent by the Father and the Son, She is sent by Christ (Commissioned)
