

Some Questions to Consider when Applying a Sermon to One's Thinking & Living

- **Salvation-Historical** - does the main point address a text that thrusts forward the unfolding plot of redemption in history?
- **Christological** - does the main point have implications for how we think about Christ Himself?
- **Call to Repentance** - does the main point call unbelievers/believers to repentance?
- **Individual Non-Christian** - does the main point have implications for the unbeliever's thinking, behavior, or motivations?
- **Public** - does the main point have implications for how we conduct ourselves in the public squares of commerce, politics, justice, and etc?
- **Individual Christian** - does the main point have implications for my own personal discipleship to Christ?
- **Local church** - does the main point have implications for how we conduct ourselves as an assembled congregation or in our corporate life together?
