### Genesis 1:26-27 (NASB95)

<sup>26</sup> Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; . . . " <sup>27</sup> **God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.**

### Romans 2:15-16 (NASB95)

<sup>15</sup> in that they show the work of **the Law written** in their **hearts**, their **conscience bearing witness** and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them, <sup>16</sup> **on the day when**, according to my gospel, **God will judge** the secrets of men through Christ Jesus.

### Romans 1:18-23 (NASB95)

. . . men who **suppress the truth in unrighteousness**, <sup>19</sup> because that which is known about God is **evident within them**; for God made it **evident to them**. <sup>20</sup> For **since the creation of the world** His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been **clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse**. <sup>21</sup> For even though they knew God, they **did not honor Him as God** or **give thanks**, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened. <sup>22</sup> Professing to be wise, they became fools, <sup>23</sup> and **exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image in the form of corruptible man** . . .

### Mark 12:28-30 (NASB95)

<sup>28</sup> One of the scribes came and heard them arguing, and recognizing that He had answered them well, asked Him, "What commandment is the foremost of all?" <sup>29</sup> Jesus answered, "The foremost is, 'HEAR, O ISRAEL! THE LORD OUR GOD IS ONE LORD: <sup>30</sup> **AND YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH.**'

### Exodus 20:3-12 (NASB95)

<sup>3</sup> "You shall have **no other gods before Me**.

<sup>4</sup> "You shall **not make for yourself an idol**, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. <sup>5</sup> "You shall **not worship them** or serve them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me, <sup>6</sup> but showing lovingkindness to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

<sup>7</sup> "You shall **not take the name of the LORD your God in vain**, for the LORD will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain.

<sup>8</sup> **Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy**. <sup>9</sup> "Six days you shall labor and do all your work, <sup>10</sup> but **the seventh day is a sabbath of the LORD your God; in it you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter**, your male or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you. <sup>11</sup> "For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; therefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day and made it holy.

<sup>12</sup> **Honor your father and your mother**, that your days may be prolonged in the land which the LORD your God gives you.

### Romans 12:1-2 (NASB95)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to **present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship**. <sup>2</sup> And **do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect**.

**Deuteronomy 6:1-9 (NASB95)**

<sup>1</sup> "Now this is the commandment, the statutes and the judgments which the LORD your God has commanded me to teach you, that you might do them in the land where you are going over to possess it, <sup>2</sup> so that you and your son and your grandson might fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged. <sup>3</sup> "O Israel, you should listen and be careful to do *it*, that it may be well with you and that you may multiply greatly, just as the LORD, the God of your fathers, has promised you, *in* a land flowing with milk and honey. <sup>4</sup> "Hear, O Israel! The LORD is our God, the LORD is one! <sup>5</sup> "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. <sup>6</sup> "These words, which I am commanding you today, shall be on your heart. <sup>7</sup> "You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. <sup>8</sup> "You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead. <sup>9</sup> "You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

**Proverbs 22:6 (NASB95)**

<sup>6</sup> Train up a child in the way he should go, Even when he is old he will not depart from it.

**2 Corinthians 5:10 (NASB95)**

<sup>10</sup> For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

**1 Corinthians 3:11-15 (NASB95)**

<sup>11</sup> For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. <sup>12</sup> Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, <sup>13</sup> each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is *to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work.* <sup>14</sup> If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. <sup>15</sup> If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

**Revelation 20:11-15 (NASB95)**

<sup>11</sup> Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. <sup>12</sup> And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is *the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books,* according to their deeds. <sup>13</sup> And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds. <sup>14</sup> Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. <sup>15</sup> And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

**Matthew 25:31-46 (NASB95)**

<sup>31</sup> "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. <sup>32</sup> "All the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; <sup>33</sup> and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left. <sup>34</sup> "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. <sup>35</sup> 'For I was hungry, and you gave Me *something* to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me *something* to drink; I was a stranger, and you invited Me in; <sup>36</sup> naked, and you clothed Me; I was sick, and you visited Me; I was in prison, and you came to Me.' <sup>37</sup> "Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, and feed You, or thirsty, and give You *something* to drink? <sup>38</sup> 'And when did we see You a stranger, and invite You in, or naked, and clothe You? <sup>39</sup> 'When did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' <sup>40</sup> "The King will answer and say to them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of these brothers of Mine, *even* the least of them, you did it to Me.' <sup>41</sup> "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; <sup>42</sup> for I was hungry, and you gave Me *nothing* to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me *nothing* to drink; <sup>43</sup> I was a stranger, and you did not invite Me in; naked, and you did not clothe Me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit Me.' <sup>44</sup> "Then they themselves also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, or thirsty, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not take care of You?' <sup>45</sup> "Then He will answer them, 'Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' <sup>46</sup> "These will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."
