## FOCUS TEXT:

### 2 Timothy 3:10-17 (NASB95)

<sup>10</sup> Now you followed my teaching, conduct, purpose, faith, patience, love, perseverance, <sup>11</sup> persecutions, *and* sufferings, such as happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium *and* at Lystra; what persecutions I endured, and out of them all the Lord rescued me! <sup>12</sup> Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. <sup>13</sup> But evil men and impostors will proceed *from bad* to worse, deceiving and being deceived. <sup>14</sup> You, however, continue in the things you have learned and become convinced of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*, <sup>15</sup> and that from childhood you have known the sacred writings which are able to give you the wisdom that leads to salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> **All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness;** <sup>17</sup> **so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.**

### Ephesians 2:8-10 (NASB95)

<sup>8</sup> For by grace **you have been saved through faith**; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God; <sup>9</sup> not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. <sup>10</sup> For we are His workmanship, **created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.**

### Romans 5:1-2 (NASB95)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore, **having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,** <sup>2</sup> through whom also we have obtained our introduction **by faith into this grace in which we stand;**

### Galatians 2:16 (NASB95)

<sup>16</sup> nevertheless knowing that **a man is not justified by the works of the Law but through faith in Christ Jesus, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, so that we may be justified by faith in Christ** and not by the works of the Law; since by the works of the Law no flesh will be justified.

### Galatians 3:11 (NASB95)

<sup>11</sup> Now that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, " **THE RIGHTEOUS MAN SHALL LIVE BY FAITH.**"

### Romans 10:17 (NASB95)

<sup>17</sup> **So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.**

**Isaiah 55:8-11 (NASB95)**

<sup>8</sup> "For My thoughts are not your thoughts, Nor are your ways My ways," declares the LORD.

<sup>9</sup> "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways And My thoughts than your thoughts. <sup>10</sup> "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven, And do not return there without watering the earth And making it bear and sprout, And furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;

<sup>11</sup> **So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; It will not return to Me empty, Without accomplishing what I desire, And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it.**

**Hebrews 4:12-13 (NASB95)**

<sup>12</sup> **For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.**

<sup>13</sup> **And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do.**

**2 Peter 1:1-8 (NASB95)**

<sup>1</sup> Simon Peter, a bond-servant and apostle of Jesus Christ,

To those who have received a faith of the same kind as ours, by the righteousness of our God and Savior, Jesus Christ: <sup>2</sup> Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord; <sup>3</sup> seeing that His divine power has granted to us **everything pertaining to life and godliness**, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. <sup>4</sup> For by these He has granted to us **His precious and magnificent promises**, so that by them you may **become partakers of the divine nature**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust. <sup>5</sup> Now for this very reason also, applying all diligence, in your faith supply moral excellence, and in *your* moral excellence, knowledge, <sup>6</sup> and in *your* knowledge, self-control, and in *your* self-control, perseverance, and in *your* perseverance, godliness, <sup>7</sup> and in *your* godliness, brotherly kindness, and in *your* brotherly kindness, love. <sup>8</sup> **For if these *qualities* are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.**
