FOCUS THEME:

Christ came to demonstrate true humility

Christ came to give us a clear conscience:
Christ came to reveal God's love for sinners:
Christ came to make His Cross the ground of all boasting:
Christ came to receive our worship:
Christ came to free us from our slavery to the fear of death:
Christ came to bring the Light/Life of God to a dark/dead world

FOCUS TEXT:

Philippians 2:5-8 (NASB95)

⁵ **Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,** ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, **did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,** ⁷ but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, *and* being made in the likeness of men. ⁸ Being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself** by becoming **obedient** to the point of death, even death on a cross.

DEFINITION:

Humble – low / modest / a sense of insignificance, inferiority and subservience / respectful / sense of lesser worth, dignity, honor and glory / meek

Philippians 2:3-4 (NASB95)

³ **Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit,** but with **humility of mind** regard one another as **more important than yourselves**; ⁴ do not *merely* look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.
