1 Corinthians 3:1 (NASB95)

¹ And I, brethren, **could not** speak to you as to **spiritual men**, but as to **men of flesh**, as to **infants in Christ**.

those who are perishing / those who are being saved

men of flesh / spiritual men

there are quarrels among you / jealousy and strife

1 Corinthians 1:10 (NASB95)

¹⁰ Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that **you all agree** and that there be **no divisions among you**, but that you be made complete in the **same mind** and in the **same judgment**.

¹⁰ **According to the grace of God** which was **given to me**,

like a **wise** master builder **I laid a foundation**,

1 Corinthians 15:3-8 (NASB95) {Gospel}

³ For **I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received**, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. ⁶ After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep; ⁷ then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles; ⁸ and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 (NASB95) {Lord's Table}

²³ **For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you**, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁵ In the same way *He took* the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me." ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.

2 Timothy 2:15 (NASB95)

¹⁵ **Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth**.

¹¹ **For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ**.

Ephesians 2:19-22 (NASB95)

¹⁹ So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of **God's household**. ²⁰ **having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone**, ²¹ in whom the whole building, being fitted together, is growing into a holy temple in the Lord, ²² in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit.

¹² Now if any man builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³ each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is *to be* revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work. ¹⁴ If any man's work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If any man's work is burned up, he will suffer loss; **but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire**.
