1 CORINTHIANS 6:12-20

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

¹² All things are lawful for me, but not all things are profitable.
All things are lawful for me, but I will not be mastered by anything.

¹³ Food is for the stomach and the stomach is for food, but God will do away with both of them.

Yet <u>the body is not for immorality, but for the Lord</u>, and the Lord is for the body. ¹⁴ Now God has not only raised the Lord, but will also raise us up through His power.

- ¹⁵ **<u>Do you not know</u>** that your bodies are <u>members of Christ</u>? Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? May it never be!
- ¹⁶ Or <u>do you not know</u> that the <u>one who joins himself to a prostitute</u> is one body *with her?* For He says, "THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH."
- ¹⁷ But the <u>one who joins himself to the Lord is one spirit with Him</u>. ¹⁸ Flee immorality. Every *other* sin that a man commits is outside the body, but the immoral man sins against his own body.

- ¹⁹ Or <u>do you not know</u> that <u>your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit</u> who is in you, whom you have from God, and that **you are not your own**?
- ²⁰ For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

Romans 12:1-2

- ¹ Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to <u>present your bodies a living</u> and <u>holy sacrifice</u>, acceptable to God, *which is* **your spiritual service of worship**.
- ² And do not be conformed to this world, but <u>be transformed by the renewing of your mind</u>, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.
