1 Corinthians 12:1-11

¹ Now **concerning spiritual gifts**, brethren, **I do not want you to be unaware**.

1 Corinthians 10:1 & 2 Corinthians 1:8

I do not want you to be unaware . . .

1 Corinthians 3:16, 5:6, 6:2, 6:3, 6:9, 6:15, 6:16, 6:19, 9:13 & 9:24

Do you not know that . . .

1 Corinthians 11:23-26

²³ **For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you**, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁵ In the same way *He took* the cup also after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.

1 Corinthians 15:3-8

³ **For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received**, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. ⁶ After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep; ⁷ then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles; ⁸ and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.

Understanding: Psalm 111:10, 119:34, 119:130, Proverbs 1:2, 2:6, 4:5, 9:10, Mark 12:28-34, Ephesians 1:18-23, Colossians 1:9-12, 1 John 5:20.

² You know that **when you were pagans, you were led astray to the mute idols, however you were led**.

1 Corinthians 10:18-21

¹⁸ Look at the nation Israel; are not those who eat the sacrifices sharers in the altar? ¹⁹ What do I mean then? That a thing sacrificed to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything? ²⁰ *No*, but *I say that* **the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to demons and not to God**; and **I do not want you to become sharers in demons**. ²¹ **You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons; you cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons**.

³ Therefore **I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"**; and **no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit**.

⁴ Now there are **varieties of gifts**, but **the same Spirit**. ⁵ And there are **varieties of ministries**, and **the same Lord**. ⁶ There are **varieties of effects**, but **the same God who works all things in all persons**.

⁷ But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

⁸ For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ¹⁰ and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another *various* kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues.

¹¹ But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.
