# 1 CORINTHIANS 15:12-20

{Sunday, October 22, 2017 A.D.}

1 Corinthians 1:18-24

<sup>18</sup> For <u>the word of the cross</u> is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it <u>is the</u> <u>power of God</u>....

... <sup>21</sup> ... God was well-pleased through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe....

#### 1 Corinthians 2:2-5

<sup>2</sup> For <u>I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified</u>.... <sup>5</sup> so that your faith would not rest on the wisdom of men, but <u>on the power of God</u>.

#### 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

<sup>1</sup> Now I make known to you, brethren, <u>the gospel</u> <u>which I preached to you, which also you received</u>, <u>in</u> <u>which also you stand</u>, <sup>2</sup> <u>by which also you are saved</u>, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, <u>unless you believed in vain</u>.

<sup>3</sup> For <u>I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received</u>, that <u>Christ died for our sins according</u> to the <u>Scriptures</u>, <sup>4</sup> and that <u>He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the</u> <u>Scriptures</u>, . . .

<sup>10</sup> But **by the grace of God I am what I am**, and **His grace toward me did not prove vain**; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me. <sup>11</sup> Whether then *it was* I or they, **so we preach and so you believed**.

#### 1 Corinthians 15:12-20

<sup>12</sup> Now <u>if Christ is preached</u>, that He has been <u>raised from the dead</u>, <u>how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?</u>

### <sup>13</sup> But <u>if there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised;</u>

<sup>14</sup> and <u>if Christ has not been raised, then</u>

our preaching is vain,

your faith also is vain.

<sup>15</sup> Moreover **we are even found** *to be* false witnesses of God, because we testified against God that He raised Christ, whom He did not raise, if in fact the dead are not raised.

<sup>16</sup> For *if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised*; <sup>17</sup> and

if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins.

<sup>18</sup> Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished.

## <sup>19</sup> If we have hoped in Christ in this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied.

<sup>20</sup> But now Christ has been raised from the dead,

the first fruits of those who are asleep.

# HEIDELBERG CATECHISM

- Q. 71. Where has Christ promised that we are as certainly washed with His blood and Spirit as with the water of Baptism?
  - **A.** In the institution of Baptism, which runs thus: Go ye, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

This promise is also repeated where the Scripture calls Baptism the washing of regeneration and the washing away of sins.
