

# JESUS' TRIUMPHAL ENTRY -- PALM SUNDAY

{April 14, 2019 A.D.}

1. God's Appropriation. **{SOVEREIGN KING}**
2. Presentation of the King of Peace/Righteousness/Glory – Praise/Prayer (Worship/Faith) response of God's people. **{SOVEREIGN KING}**
3. Christ's lament over the people's failure to recognize the time of God's coming (visitation) to them. **{PROPHET/JUDGE}**
4. Who is this???? Jesus the prophet from Nazareth in Galilee. **{PROPHET/MESSIAH-CHRIST/GOD INCARNATE, GOD WITH US (Person/Teaching/Ministry)}**
5. Cleansing of the temple. **{HIGH PRIEST}**
6. Indignation of the religious leadership to the prophetic voice of God.
7. Response of the Greek Gentiles.

## 1<sup>st</sup> COMING of CHRIST:

**Matthew 21:1-17   Mark 11:1-12   Mark 11:15-18   Luke 19:29-48   John 12:12-22   (John 2:13-25 not included)**

### □ Addresses:

- Judgment beginning in the "**House of God**" (1 Peter 4:17).
- Commercialization of worship/faith ("**Den of Robbers**" – Canaanites & unfaithful/hireling Under-Shepherds).
- Greatest defilement of the Temple (**Church/Heart – false worship**).
- Instead of true faith, misplaced confidence/**presumption in hypocritical worship**.
- **God's inclusion in His chosen remnant**, representatives from many tribes/tongues.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> COMING of CHRIST:

**Revelation 19:11-16**

<sup>11</sup> And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and **He who sat on it is called Faithful and True**, and **in righteousness He judges and wages war**.<sup>12</sup> . . . and **He has a name written on Him which no one knows except Himself**.

<sup>13</sup> **He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood**, and His name is called **The Word of God**.<sup>14</sup> . . .

<sup>15</sup> **From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations**, and **He will rule them with a rod of iron**; and **He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty**.<sup>16</sup> And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "**KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS**."

**Revelation 5:9-14**

<sup>9</sup> And they sang a new song, saying, "**Worthy are You . . . for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation**."<sup>10</sup> "**You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to our God**; and they will reign upon the earth."<sup>11</sup> . . . I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands,<sup>12</sup> saying with a loud voice, "**Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing**."

<sup>13</sup> And every created thing . . . I heard saying,

"**To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever**." . . .

## *Chapter 8: Of Christ the Mediator*

10. This number and order of offices is **necessary**; . . . we stand in **need of His prophetic office**; . . . we **need His priestly office** . . . ;

and **in respect to our averseness and utter inability to return to God, and for our rescue and security from our spiritual adversaries, we need His kingly office to convince, subdue, draw, uphold, deliver, and preserve us to His heavenly kingdom.**

## *Chapter 17: Of The Perseverance {Preservation} of the Saints*

1. **Those whom God hath accepted in the beloved, . . . can neither totally nor finally fall from the state of grace, but shall certainly persevere {be preserved} therein to the end, and be eternally saved, . . .**

**He is still the same, and they shall be sure to be kept by the power of God unto salvation, . . . ,**

**they being engraven upon the palm of His hands, and their names having been written in the book of life from all eternity.**
