### 2 Corinthians 13:1

<sup>1</sup> This is the third time I am coming to you.

### EVERY FACT IS TO BE CONFIRMED BY THE TESTIMONY OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES.

### Deuteronomy 17:6

<sup>6</sup> "On the evidence of two witnesses or three witnesses, he who is to die shall be put to death; he shall not be put to death on the evidence of one witness.

#### Galatians 5:19-23

- <sup>19</sup> Now <u>the deeds of the flesh</u> are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, <sup>20</sup> idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, <sup>21</sup> envying, drunkenness, carousing, and <u>things like these</u>, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that <u>those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God</u>.
- <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

#### 2 Corinthians 13:2-5

- <sup>2</sup> I have previously said when present the second time, and though now absent I say in advance to those who have <u>sinned in the past</u> and to all the rest *as well*, that <u>if I come again I will not spare *anyone*,</u>
- <sup>3</sup> since you are seeking for proof of the Christ who speaks in me, and who is not weak toward you, but mighty in you.
- <sup>4</sup> For indeed **He was crucified because of weakness**, yet **He lives because of the power of God**.

For <u>we also are weak in Him</u>, yet <u>we will live with Him because of the power of God</u> *directed* toward you.

<sup>5</sup> Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith; examine yourselves!

Or <u>do you not recognize this about yourselves</u>, <u>that Jesus Christ is in you—unless indeed you fail the test?</u>

## **HEIDELBERG CATECHISM** -- {1563}

- Q. 129. What is the meaning of the word Amen? {LORD's Prayer}
  - **A.** Amen means: **So shall it truly and surely be**. For my prayer is much more certainly heard of God, than I feel in my heart that I desire these things of Him.
