Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit,

but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

⁵ Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but **emptied Himself**, taking the **form of a bond-servant**, and being made in the likeness of men. ⁸ Being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself** by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

the God of love and peace will be with you.

- ¹² Greet one another with a holy kiss. ¹³ All the saints greet you.
 - Commitment to a common body of essential beliefs (the faith that is produced by the Bible not sterile cognitive knowledge).
 - Faithfulness to a common life of obedience.
 - Sharing a common love of God.
 - Sharing a common love of fellowman, especially, other believers (Created in the Image of God + Redeemed by the Cross of Christ).
 - Sharing a common eternal destiny/treasure/purpose/Owner.
 - Sharing a common Grace / Communion of the Body of Christ.
