

# The Lord's Table

{Sunday, July 7, 2019 A.D.}

## Exodus 12:1-20

<sup>1</sup> Now **the LORD said** to Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt,

<sup>2</sup> **"This month shall be the beginning of months for you; it is to be the first month of the year to you.**

<sup>3</sup> "Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying, 'On the tenth of this month they are each one to take a lamb for themselves, according to their fathers' households, a lamb for each household. . . . <sup>6</sup> 'You shall keep it until the fourteenth day of the same month, then the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel is to kill it at twilight. . . . —**it is the LORD'S Passover.** <sup>12</sup> 'For I will go through the land of Egypt on that night, and . . .

**I will execute judgments—I am the LORD.** <sup>13</sup> 'The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood **I will pass over you**, and **no plague will befall you to destroy you when I strike the land.** . . .

<sup>14</sup> 'Now **this day will be a memorial to you**, and **you shall celebrate it as a feast to the LORD; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance.** . . .

<sup>17</sup> **'You shall also observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread**, for on this very day I brought your hosts out of the land of Egypt; therefore **you shall observe this day throughout your generations as a permanent ordinance.**

<sup>18</sup> **'In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at evening, you shall eat unleavened bread, until the twenty-first day of the month at evening.** . . .

## John 1:29

<sup>29</sup> The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said,

**"Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"**

## Matthew 26:17-30

<sup>17</sup> Now **on the first day of Unleavened Bread** the disciples came to Jesus and asked,

**"Where do You want us to prepare for You to eat the Passover?"** <sup>18</sup> And He said, "Go into the city to a certain man, and say to him, **'The Teacher says, "My time is near; I am to keep the Passover** at your house with My disciples.'"

<sup>19</sup> The disciples did as Jesus had directed them; and **they prepared the Passover.** <sup>20</sup> Now when evening came, Jesus was reclining *at the table* with the twelve disciples. . . . <sup>26</sup> While they were eating, **Jesus took some bread**, and **after a blessing**, He broke *it* and gave *it* to the disciples, and said,

**"Take, eat; this is My body."** <sup>27</sup> And when **He had taken a cup** and **given thanks**, He gave *it* to them, saying, **"Drink from it, all of you;**

<sup>28</sup> **for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.** <sup>29</sup> "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until **that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."**

<sup>30</sup> After singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

## 1 Corinthians 11:23-33

<sup>23</sup> **For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you**, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread; <sup>24</sup> and when **He had given thanks**, He broke it and said,

**"This is My body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of Me."**

<sup>25</sup> In the same way *He took* the cup also after supper, saying, **"This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.**

<sup>26</sup> **For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.**

<sup>27</sup> Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord. <sup>28</sup> But a man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. <sup>29</sup> For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly.

<sup>30</sup> For this reason many among you are weak and sick, and a number sleep. <sup>31</sup> But if we judged ourselves rightly, we would not be judged. <sup>32</sup> But when we are judged, we are disciplined by the Lord so that we will not be condemned along with the world. <sup>33</sup> So then, my brethren, when you come together to eat, wait for one another.
