...²⁰Keep yourselves in the love of God...

JUDE 17 But you, <u>beloved</u>, ought to <u>remember the words</u> that were <u>spoken beforehand by the</u> apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁸that they were saying to you,

"In the last time there will be mockers, following after their own ungodly lusts." ¹⁹These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded, devoid of the Spirit.

²⁰But you beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, waiting anxiously for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to eternal life.

The Sovereignty of God over salvation VS. Man's responsibility to:

"Repent" and "believe" and "be saved from this perverse generation." To "Remember the words spoken beforehand... "That there will be mockers" to "build ourselves up..." to "Keep ourselves in the love of God" "Abide in My Love" "Love one another"

...⁷Do not be deceived, <u>God is not mocked</u>; for whatever a man sows, he will also reap. ⁸For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but <u>the one who sows to the</u> Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

⁹Just as the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you, abide in My love. ¹⁰If you keep My commandments, you will abide in my love... ¹²This is My commandment, that you love one another just as I have loved you. ¹³Greater love has no one than this, that one lay down his life for His friends... ¹⁶You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give to you.

Ephesians 1:4-14

...⁴just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. In love ⁵He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself... ⁶to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the beloved. ⁷In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace ⁸which He lavished on us...¹³In Him, you also after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed In Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, ¹⁴who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory.
