Romans 12, Romans 13, Romans 14, Romans 15 describes God's will for us in Christ- Our sanctification

1 Thessalonians 4:1-

Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you receive from us instruction as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more. ²For you know what commandments we gave you by the authority of the Lord Jesus. ³For this is the will of God, your sanctification; that is, that you abstain from sexual immorality...

(Putting on Christ in your mind)

Romans 12:1-3

¹Therefore I urge you, brethren, **by the mercies of God**, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. ²And do not be conformed to this world, but <u>be transformed by the renewing of your mind</u>, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. ³For through the grace given me I say to everyone among you <u>not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think;</u> but to <u>think so as to have sound judgement</u>, as **God has allotted to each a measure of faith**.

Romans 6: 1-23

...³Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ have been baptized into His death? ⁴Therfore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory

of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵For if we have been united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection, knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that the old body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; for he who has died with Christ is freed from sin...

(Putting on Christ in your memory)

Psalm 111 ... ²Great are the works of the LORD; They are <u>studied by all who</u> <u>delight in them.</u> ³Splendid and majestic are His works, and His righteousness endures forever. ⁴He has made His wonders to be remembered...

Psalm 1:1—6 ... ¹How blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked,... ²But his delight is in the law of the LORD and <u>in His law he meditates day and night...</u>

Luke 2:41-51 ... ^{51b}and His mother treasured all these things in her heart.

2Timothy 2:1-8 ⁷Consider what I say, for the Lord will give you understanding in everything. ⁸Remember <u>Jesus Christ, risen from the dead</u>, descendant of David according to my gospel...but the word of God is not imprisoned...

Romans 12:1-21 Paul reminds himself and the believers of God's sovereign grace. ...²¹Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

(Putting on Christ in your conscience)

Romans 13:1-14 ¹Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God... ⁵Therefore it is necessary to be in subjection, not only because of God's wrath, but also for conscience sake.... ⁷Render to all what is due them: tax to whom tax is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honor to whom honor.

Romans 14:1-23 ... ¹Now accept the one who is weak in faith, but not for the purpose of passing judgement on his opinions... ⁵Each person must be fully convinced in his own mind... ⁵For not one of us lives for himself, and not one of us dies for himself;...whether we live or die, we are the Lord's.
