**Supplement:**

**Mark 3:1-6**

<sup>1</sup> He entered again into a synagogue; and a man was there whose hand was withered.

<sup>2</sup> **They were watching Him to see if He would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him.** <sup>3</sup> He said to the man with the withered hand, "Get up and come forward!"

<sup>4</sup> And He said to them,

**"Is it lawful to do good or to do harm on the Sabbath, to save a life or to kill?"**

**But they kept silent.**

<sup>5</sup> **After looking around at them with anger,** grieved at their hardness of heart, He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored.

<sup>6</sup> The Pharisees went out and immediately *began* conspiring with the Herodians against Him, *as to* how they might destroy Him.

**Ephesians 4:25-32**

<sup>25</sup> Therefore, laying aside falsehood, SPEAK TRUTH EACH ONE *of you* WITH HIS NEIGHBOR, for we are members of one another.

<sup>26</sup> **BE ANGRY, AND yet DO NOT SIN;**

**do not let the sun go down on your anger,**

<sup>27</sup> **and do not give the devil an opportunity.**

<sup>28</sup> He who steals must steal no longer; but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good, so that he will have *something* to share with one who has need. <sup>29</sup> Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a *word* as is good for edification according to the need *of the moment*, so that it will give grace to those who hear. <sup>30</sup> Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

<sup>31</sup> Let **all bitterness and wrath and anger** and clamor and slander **be put away from you, along with all malice.**

<sup>32</sup> Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.
