## James 1:17-18

<sup>17</sup> **Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights,** with whom there is **no variation or shifting shadow.** <sup>18</sup> **In the exercise of His will He brought us forth by the word of truth,** so that we would be **a kind of first fruits among His creatures.**

## James 4:1-5

<sup>4</sup> **You adulteresses,** do you not know that **friendship with the world is hostility toward God?** Therefore **whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.**

<sup>5</sup> Or **do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose:** **"He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us"?**

### Isaiah 55:11

<sup>11</sup> **So will My word be** which goes forth from My mouth; **it will not return to Me empty. Without accomplishing what I desire,** And **without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.**

### Isaiah 46:9-11

<sup>9</sup> Remember the former things long past, For **I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is no one like Me,** <sup>10</sup> **Declaring the end from the beginning,** And from ancient times things which have not been done, Saying, **"My purpose will be established, And I will accomplish all My good pleasure";**

<sup>11</sup> Calling a bird of prey from the east, The man of My purpose from a far country. **Truly I have spoken; truly I will bring it to pass. I have planned it, surely I will do it.**

### Hebrews 4:12-13

<sup>12</sup> For **the word of God is living and active** and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and **able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.** <sup>13</sup> And **there is no creature hidden from His sight,** but **all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him** with whom we have to do.

## James 4:6-10

<sup>6</sup> But **He gives a greater grace.**

Therefore *it* says, **"GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE."**

<sup>7</sup> **Submit therefore to God.**

**Resist the devil** and **he will flee from you.**

<sup>8</sup> **Draw near to God** and **He will draw near to you.**

**Cleanse your hands,** you sinners; and **purify your hearts,** you double-minded.

<sup>9</sup> Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy to gloom.

<sup>10</sup> **Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord,** and

**He will exalt you.**
