## Isaiah 45:5-7

<sup>5</sup> **"I am the LORD, and there is no other; Besides Me there is no God.**  
I will gird you, though you have not known Me; <sup>6</sup> That men may know from the rising to the setting of the sun  
That **there is no one besides Me. I am the LORD, and there is no other,**  
<sup>7</sup> **The One forming light and creating darkness, Causing well-being and creating calamity;**  
**I am the LORD** who does all these.

## James 4:13-15

<sup>13</sup> Come now, **you** who **say**, "**Today** or **tomorrow** we **will go** to **such and such a city**, and **spend a year there** and **engage in business** and **make a profit.**"

<sup>14</sup> Yet **you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow.**  
You are *just* **a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away.**

<sup>15</sup> Instead, *you ought* to say, "**If the Lord wills, we will live** and also **do this or that.**"

## James 5:1-6

<sup>1</sup> Come now, you **rich**, **weep and howl** for **your miseries which are coming upon you.**

<sup>2</sup> Your riches have rotted and your garments have become moth-eaten.

<sup>3</sup> Your **gold** and your **silver** have **rusted**; and  
**their rust** will be **a witness against you** and **will consume your flesh like fire.**

It is in the last days that you have stored up your treasure!

<sup>4</sup> Behold, the pay of the laborers who mowed your fields, *and* which has been withheld by you,  
cries out *against you*; and

the outcry of those who did the harvesting has reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth.

<sup>5</sup> You have lived luxuriously on the earth and led a life of wanton pleasure;  
you have fattened your hearts in a day of slaughter.

<sup>6</sup> You have condemned and put to death the righteous *man*; he does not resist you.
