INTRODUCTION - PART IX

{Sunday, August 2, 2020 A.D.}

Main Themes:

- ✓ Eyewitness testimony regarding the *The Gospel Message*; *The Word of Life* manifested in the incarnation, *Son of God/Son of Man* {the full deity and humanity of Jesus Christ, two complete natures, yet one person}.
- ✓ Jesus Christ, our Advocate with the Father.
- ✓ Holiness of God.
- ✓ Assurance of Salvation; the practice of Righteousness.
- ✓ The love of God the Father as precedent to our true biblical love of God and our brothers and sister in Christ.
- ✓ The New Commandment; Love one another. Self-sacrificial love, to love as Jesus Christ loves (to love as God loves).
- ✓ Orthodoxy and Orthopraxy; Right doctrine for the purpose of right practice {belief and behavior / good seed and good fruit / faith and works / walking worthily /faith and life / etc.
- ✓ The **discerning/testing/judging** of "the spirits." Ever reforming one's self and the church.
- ✓ Warning against false teachers and their heretical teaching.
- ✓ True Believers versus false converts / antichrists / deceivers / wolves / false teachers / goats / tares / etc.
- ✓ Antichrists; Every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh.
- Love and Propitiation, {we do not normally think about these concepts as belonging together}.
- Born of God / Born Again / Born from Above {regeneration / passed out of death into eternal life in Christ}.
- Overcoming the world {the final triumph of The Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, King of kings and Lord of lords, The Kingdom of God, The Church and The Gospel.
- The Exclusivity of Jesus Christ.
- The theological criteria conditioning the believer's extension of hospitality.
- The Last Days.
- Eternal Life in Christ.
- The importance of viewing these three short epistles as the word of almighty God, breathed out by His Holy Spirit, and necessary for faith and life.

Born of God / Born Again / Born from Above (regeneration / passed out of death into eternal life in Christ).

Overcoming the world (the final triumph of The Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, King of kings and Lord of lords, The Kingdom of God, The Church and The Gospel,.

John 1:12-13

¹² But <u>as many as received Him</u>, to them He gave the right to <u>become children of God</u>, even to <u>those who believe in His name</u>, ¹³ who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

John 3:3

³ Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, <u>unless one is born again</u> he <u>cannot see</u> the kingdom of God."

1 Peter 1:23

²³ for you <u>have been born again</u> <u>not of seed which is perishable</u> but imperishable, *that is,* **through the living and enduring word of God**.

John 5:24

²⁴ "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who <u>hears My word, and believes</u> <u>Him who sent Me</u>, <u>has</u> eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.

1 John 3:14

¹⁴ We know that we <u>have passed out of death</u> into life, because <u>we love the brethren</u>. He who does not love abides in death.

1 John 5:1-5

¹ Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and whoever loves the Father loves the child born of Him. ² By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and observe His commandments. ³ For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome. ⁴ For whatever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. ⁵ Who is the one who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

¹⁰ Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying,

"Now the salvation, and the power, and the kingdom of our God and the authority of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren has been thrown down, he who accuses them before our God day and night. ¹¹ "And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.

¹¹ And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it *is* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war. ¹² His eyes *are* a flame of fire, and on His head *are* many diadems; and He has a name written *on Him* which no one knows except Himself. ¹³ *He is* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called <u>The Word of God</u>. ¹⁴ And the armies which are in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white *and* clean, were following Him on white horses. ¹⁵ From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. ¹⁶ And on His robe and on His thigh He has a name written, "KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS."

31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us? . . . 33 Who will bring a charge against God's elect? God is the one who justifies; 34 who is the one who condemns? . . . 35 Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness,

or peril, or sword? . . . ³⁷ But in all these things we <u>overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us</u>. ³⁸ For <u>I am convinced</u> that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be <u>able to separate us</u> from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
